Primary duties include development, maintenance, and support of applications such as the remote patron access proxy service (currently EZProxy) and the OpenURL link resolver service (currently SFX). ### **Qualifications**

A Masters degree in Library Science from a recognized post-secondary institution is essential. A minimum of two years of relevant work experience is required. Experience with SFX or EZProxy is desirable, along with knowledge of metadata and electronic resources, and Unix/Linux operating system. Experience in a consortium environment is an asset. Equivalencies will be considered.

**Salary and Benefits:** The annual salary range for this position is \$58,500 to \$72,000.
